THEME

The theme of the conference surrounds around the chemical aspects of tropical plants. A wide range of natural products with remarkable skeletal build-up and multiple-functionality can be obtained from renewable resources. From a medicinal standpoint, many natural products provide a rich source of bioactive agents, such as antitumor, antibacterial, anti-insecticidal, anthelmintic, antinematodal, immunosuppressives and also have been widely exploited for both synthetic and semisynthetic drug discovery and development efforts. Though the plants are a rich source of secondary metabolites, the number of plants that have been extensively studied is relatively low, only 5%. The focus on plant research around the world has now increased and numerous lines of evidence have been gathered to demonstrate the enormous potential of medicinal plants. Reorienting the scientific research based on tropical plants will be a boost to the ongoing academic and research activities. The conference will feature plenary lecture, invited lecture, short oral presentations, poster presentations and focused sessions in the synthetic, clinical, biological and functional exploration of natural products obtained from various plant sources. This event will be an inspiration to students and faculty for practicing science and realize the significance of the same.
