Sub: Advanced Management programme (AMP-18<sup>th</sup>) 18<sup>th</sup> Edition, 2013 to be conducted by Management Development Institute, Gurgaon from 26.08.2013 to 22.09.2013.

Management Development Institute (MDI), Gurgaon has invited nomination for the four weeks fully residential Advanced Management Programme, 18<sup>th</sup> Edition to be conducted by MDI, Gurgaon from 26.08.2013 to 22.09.2013. The above said programme has been split into two components. One for the Indian Phase of the programme and one for the Overseas Learning Programme. The first phase (Weeks 1 and 2) of the AMP is held at the MDI campus at Gurgaon in which the participants will cover issues of building global competitiveness and its impact on Business Strategy as a whole. In the Indian phase, eminent guest speakers are invited to interact with the participants so that sharing of knowledge happens. The second phase of the AMP (week 3 and 4) is spent with key Business Schools and Industries in Europe. In Phase-II, based on what has been discussed and gathered during the first two weeks, participants will be exposed to some of the current thinking and best practices in International Business. For this, the participants would get academic inputs for two weeks at leading Business Schools viz., ESCP-Europe, European School of Management at Berlin and at Paris, Frankfurt School of Finance & Management, Frankfurt, Germany; University of Antwerp, Belgium and HHL-Leipzig Graduate School of Management Leipzig, Germany. Further a few industry visits will be organized, which will help participants to not only understand how businesses are managed in Europe but also appreciate the opportunities available to Indian organisations in Europe. ICAR intends to depute some officers of the rank of Deputy Secretaries/equivalent officers and above level officers from the ICAR Hqrs./Institutes for this programme. The programme fee for the Indian Phase and Overseas Learning Programme (including hotel accommodation charges during OLP) in respect of all the participants will be borne by the Council. However the cost of per-diem, Visa fees and any other incidental charges during Overseas Learning Programme which comes to Rs.45,250/- will have to be borne by the participant out of his/ her own funds.
