Dates: February 14-23, 2017

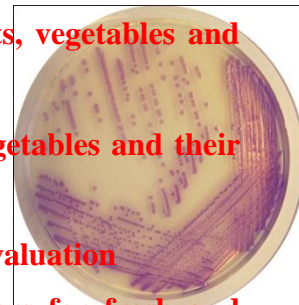
Objectives of the training programme

To impart training in the analysis of nutritional and biochemical parameters for fresh and processed fruit and vegetable products

Accommodation and Boarding
