The National Institute of Plant Health Management (An autonomous Institute under Department of Agriculture and Cooperation, Ministry of Agriculture) is premier capacity building institute in the field of Plant Health Management, Biosecurity and Incursion Management and Pesticide Management. The Institute is organizing above mentioned training programme from 8 to 28th April, 2015.

The Plant Quarantine system is the first line of defense against the introduction and possible establishment of exotic pests. It is essential to identify quarantine pests of concern to India to prevent its introduction and spread. Accurate diagnosis at appropriate time can save the nation from exotic pest incursions. The training will enable the participants to identify:

1. Pathways for pest introduction
2. Domestic and Quarantine Fruit flies identification and monitoring
3. Weed seeds of quarantine significance
4. Seed health testing methods
5. Molecular diagnosis: using ELISA, PCR

NIPHM will provide lodging and boarding free of cost and reimbursement of transport charges. The travel expenses will be reimbursed subject to shortest route from place of posting to NIPHM and back, for entitled class but restricted to II-tier, AC rail fare on the production of original tickets/vouchers. No air-fare will be approved or restricted to II-tier AC rail fare from nearest point to Hyderabad.
