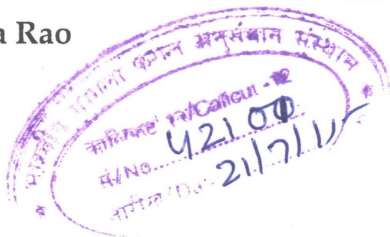

Background

Gender mainstreaming is a tool for achieving gender equality. In the present scenario, it is essential for all public programmes to mainstream a gender perspective in designing, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of policies and programmes in all political, economic and social spheres and further strengthen the capabilities of the system in the area of gender equality and women's empowerment. The acknowledgement of women's central role in agriculture should entail the strengthening of institutions working in this area in order to equip them to adequately integrate gender equality in programmes at every level.

NARS professionals serving in the three core areas of agricultural research, extension and education need to improve their awareness and knowledge regarding various concepts related to gender such as gender analysis, gender budgeting, gender auditing, gender equality, gender equity etc. and their application in their respective work places in order to mainstream gender for holistic agricultural development. Such knowledge and mastery of the concept demands effective capacity building programmes in this area. With this aim, a short course has been contemplated by ICAR-NAARM with financial support of ICAR to train faculty members, extension personnel and scientists of NARS in the area of gender mainstreaming with the following objectives:

Objectives

- To sensitize entry and middle level NARS professionals about the concept of gender and gender mainstreaming
- To enhance the competency of NARS professionals in using various tools and techniques of gender mainstreaming in agriculture
- To impart appropriate skills for mainstreaming gender in agricultural research, extension and education

Core Content

- Understanding the concept of gender in agriculture
- Gender and development issues – approaches, policies, constitutional provisions and programmes
- Status of women in agriculture: National and international perspectives
- Gender issues in agricultural research and technology delivery
- Gender and legal framework in Indian context
- Gender analysis and different frameworks
- Mainstreaming gender into bio-diversity, leadership and governance
- Mainstreaming gender for effective managerial roles
- Policy planning for gender mainstreaming in agriculture

Pedagogy

The course will provide an excellent opportunity to have a theoretical and practical exposure to understand the concept of gender mainstreaming and how it can be applied in various spheres of agricultural development right from educational planning to research and extension activities. Each participant would be sensitized about the importance of gender mainstreaming and various ways of considering gender equally and equitably. The course consists of a blend of hands-on-exercises, lectures, discussions and exposure visits. However, the course emphasizes on hands-on-exercises to enable participants to internalize the knowledge and skills imparted in the training. This might necessitate extension of the class hours beyond the regular 0930 hrs to 1630 hrs.

Duration and Venue

The course is offered during Sept. 9-18, 2015. The participants are expected to arrive latest by the evening of Sept. 8, 2015 and can leave after 1700 hrs on the last day of the programme. The programme will be held at ICAR - National Academy of Agricultural Research Management, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad-500030. The programme is completely residential.

Eligibility

- The programme is mainly targeted at the entry and middle level NARS professionals including KVKs, who are actively involved in technology transfer and decision making activities
- Working not below the rank of Assistant Professor and equivalent in any of the agricultural disciplines under State Agricultural University/ICAR Institute/Agricultural Universities/Agricultural faculty of Aligarh Muslim University/BHU, Varanasi/Vishwa Bharti and Nagaland University

Selection of Participants

Maximum intake for the programme is 25 participants. As per the eligibility criteria,

selection would be based on first-cum-first basis. A formal confirmation letter indicating the selection of candidates will be sent by ICAR-NAARM a week after the last date for the receipt of nominations. Selected participants are expected to bring their present assignments pertaining to gender mainstreaming or gender analysis for presentation.

Nominations

Nominations through proper channel may be sent to NAARM so as to reach **on or before August 15, 2015. The selected candidates will be intimated by third week of August 2015 by e-mail.**

Registration

There is no course fee, however, a non-refundable registration fee of Rs. 50/- (Rupees Fifty only) is to be paid by way of a Postal Order (drawn in favour of ICAR Unit, NAARM payable at Hyderabad).

TA and DA

Participants will be paid to and from journey fare performed by the shortest route by rail or bus or other means of transport. The payment will be made as per their entitlement but **restricted to the maximum of AC II tier train fare**. If any participant chooses to travel by Air, he/she may do so, but their claim shall be restricted to AC II tier train fare, provided they travel by Air India and book the tickets with ICAR code (095). Participants are required to produce a photo-copy of the rail / bus / air tickets (only by public transport) and original onward boarding pass for reimbursing the travel expenditure.

Board and Lodging

Participants will be provided rent-free accommodation, wholesome meals and refreshments. Local participants will be provided lunch and inter-sessions tea only.

Travel

Hyderabad is well connected by air, rail and road from all parts of the country. One can reach NAARM located in Acharya N.G. Ranga Agricultural University campus, Rajendranagar / Professor Jayashankar Telangana State Agricultural University by city bus route No 95A from Koti to Agricultural college bus stop, or 94H or 94R to Rajendranagar bus stop which are 1.5 kms from the Academy or by 95R which plies limited trips from Koti to Rajendranagar via NAARM Campus or by taxi/auto. Participants are advised to make their return reservations well in advance at their end.
