

Training Programme on Developing Winning Research Proposals in Agricultural Research (August 25-29, 2015)



The ICAR-National Academy of Agricultural Research Management (NAARM), Hyderabad announces a **Training Programme on Developing Winning Research Proposals in Agricultural Research** from **August 25-29, 2015** at Hyderabad

Background

Every scientist in NARS needs to know how to write convincing research proposals. In the times of increasing competition for scarce research funding, it is vital for the scientists of agricultural research organizations to design projects that can attract external funding for specific research efforts. Research proposals are both large and small. It would be appreciated if one develops a vision for a project with multi-disciplinary perspective and in public-private partnerships. Some scientists are adept at writing successful and winning proposals but others experience difficulties. What makes a proposal into a winner? With this rationale in mind, this training programme is being organized for the benefit of bringing awareness and building necessary skills among the scientists of NARS.

Objectives

To develop the skills for writing research proposals that can win funds from donors focusing on the needs of the stakeholders.

- To give practice in writing various components of a research proposal.
- To explain the use of log frame, priority setting, and programme evaluation and review techniques in research programme planning.
- To develop a good project design and estimate that is rationally accepted.

Content

Overview of agricultural research projects, contextual understanding, sharing examples of winning type research proposals, research program planning using AHP & other management tools, clarifying research objectives at conceptual level and implementation level, hands on practice on project logframe, stakeholder analysis, online communication tools, data visualization.

Methodology

The programme will consist of a blend of lectures, case analysis, discussions and exercises. The participants will have an opportunity to assess the improvement of their own proposals.

Expected Learning Outputs

- Writing a good concept note as a preamble to the research proposal
- Writing and presenting winning research proposals to external donors
- Use of project management techniques

Programme Fee

Non-ICAR participants: Rs 7,000/- which includes Training Kit/material, board, lodging charges of NAARM Guesthouses/Hostels excluding TA/DA. Participants from **ICAR**, there is no course fee, but they have to pay board & lodging charges that will cost about Rs 600/- per day.

The programme fee may be paid through a demand draft drawn in favour of "**ICAR Unit-NAARM**", payable at Hyderabad; sent along with the Nomination Form or Submit at the time of registration. Scientists in ICAR, Agricultural Universities and KVK, Scientists from NGOs and General Universities working in agricultural and related disciplines

Boarding and Lodging

All participants are expected to stay in the well-furnished Halls of Residence or Scientists' Home on twin-sharing basis. Participants are requested not to bring any family members with them.

Travel

ICAR-NAARM is located in Rajendranagar (17°18'49"N latitude and 78°24'42" East longitude) in Hyderabad about 20 km from the Hyderabad Rajiv Gandhi International Airport, Shamshabad; 25 km from the Secunderabad Railway Station; 16 km from the Hyderabad Railway Station; 16 km from the Kacheguda Railway Station and 12 km from the Imlibun/Mahatma Gandhi Bus Station (MGBS). From any of these alighting points, participants can take an autorickshaw/taxi/car. Hyderabad has a salubrious climate with an elevation of 475m above the MSL. The annual rainfall is about 800 mm mostly during June to October from the southwest monsoon. Minimal rainfall is received during November to May. The

annual mean temperature is about 26°C (78.8°F). Summer is hot (exceed 40°C or 104°F) and winter (December) is moderately cold (from 10°C or 50°F and above).

Travel TA & DA has to be met by the participants/sponsoring organizations.
