Eligibility Conditions:

1. He/She should be a Scientist of Grade/level of 'D' or above.
2. He/She should have put up minimum of 12 years of service
3. His/Her age should be less than or equal to 55 years as on 01.07.2013
4. He/She should be participating in the 5-week DST sponsored Advanced Techno Management programme for the first time.

The entire cost of the training programme is being borne by the Deptt. of Science & Technology, Govt. of India except travel expenses. The participating organization has to pay to & fro travel expenses of their nominees.

The eligible Scientists, who have put in 12 years of service and are desirous to attend the said programme may send their nomination in the prescribed format(enclosed) through proper channel latest by 29.07.2013 for onward transmission to ASCI, Hyderabad.

The Scientists who have already attended this programme need not apply. The applicants will not be allowed to withdraw their nominations after acceptance by ASCI, Hyderabad.
