1.	Lease deed of farm.	FS may contact the Principal CCF for further follow up action.	FS / AAO (Estt)
2.	Cleaning office buildings and harvesting coconut trees for 2011-12 on contract basis.	Recommended. Quotations may be invited.	AAO (Stores/Works) / FS
3.	Providing temporary fence for ginger and turmeric beds on contract basis.	Estimate for the work may be provided for appropriate recommendation by the FAC	FS / SIC
4.	Repair of compound wall damaged by the elephant using welded mesh.	Estimate for the work may be provided for appropriate recommendation by the FAC	FS / SIC
5.	Repairing damaged pipe lines 500 m.	Recommended. Proposal may be submitted. In future all pipelines may be buried in the soil to avoid damage by elephants.	FS / SIC
6.	Propagation of tree spices-raising root stock, grafting, rooting etc under Seed Project and NHM.	Recommended. Proposal may be submitted.	FS / SIC / PI (SP & NHM)
7.	Handing over multiplication of black pepper from Seed Project to NHM.	May be discussed in the Seed Committee for appropriate recommendation.	Seed Committee
8.	Clearing drainage channels (3000 m).	Recommended. Proposal may be submitted.	FS / SIC
9.	Digging of elephant trenches	A letter may be addressed to Principal CCF regarding digging of elephant trenches around the boundary of the farm	FS / SIC

2. All pesticides banned for use in Kerala should not be used in the farm.
