## **SARANI POOKKALAM COMPETITION 2015**

A. There shall be four teams in the competition. Teams have been made including Staff and students only, with more or less the same strength. Apprentices may associate with their respective Divisions/Sections. The composition of teams is given below.

☐ I: Crop Improvement, ATIC, AICRP, Social Science

II: Crop Protection, DISC

☐ III: Crop Production

☐ IV: Administration, Accounts, Library, Hindi Cell, Farm

### ***B. Guidelines***

Each group may make their own arrangements for mobilizing funds, purchasing flowers, preparing sketch etc. which may be completed in advance. Use of markers for preparing sketch on the floor should be avoided. The dimension of the pookkalam is decided as 4 ftX4 ft, however there is no restriction on the shape of the pookkalam. Natural flowers or flower petals should constitute more than 80% of the total area allotted. Use of leaves and shredded coconut should be minimised in the pookkalam. Paraphernalia such as lamps, nirapara, pookula, colour powder etc. must be avoided. You may draw the design previous day itself to save time.

Timing specified (8.30-11.00 AM) may be strictly adhered. The pookkalam should be ready for inspection by sharp 11.00 AM. The judgment will be based on design, innovation and creativity, combination of colours, overall appearance and neatness.
