**Proceedings of the meeting with Director during his visit to Peruvannamuzhi
farm on 22-09-2010**

Director visited IISR, Peruvannamuzhi farm on 22-09-2010. He visited the experimental fields and reviewed the progress of various works in the farm. Following points were discussed.

- General maintenance of farm to be taken up in connection with the proposed visit of DDG during October 2010. All the scientists may cooperate. But the experimental plots to be shown to DDG also need to be looked after. Heads of division may look into this.
- Name boards are to be provided in all the experiments plots. (All the concerned scientists/FS/SIC).
- A diesel operated pump and an overhead tank to be provided near the well in the residential area. Necessary proposal may be sent to works committee and discussed in FAC (FS/SIC).
- Sunhemp seeds may be sown in the fallow land where ginger and turmeric is to be planted next year (Dr.C.K. Thankamani/ Dr. K. Kandiannan/FS/SIC).
- Quality of farm yard manure obtained from KVK is to be analyzed (Dr.R Dinesh).
- Feasibility of propagating black pepper during lean season at IISR, Calicut alone may be explored and nursery at P'muzhi can be at maintenance for these months. (Dr. C.K.Thankamani/ Dr. K. Kandiannan/FS/SIC).
