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Proceedings of KVK review meeting held on 10.11.2016 at ICAR-IISR, Kozhikode

The KVK Review meeting was held on 10.11.2016 at IISR and was chaired by Dr.K Nirmal Babu, Director, ICAR-IISR, Kozhikode. The chairman reviewed the actions taken on the decisions of last KVK review meeting. The progress report of October 2016 and proposed to be undertaken during November 2016 are presented by the programme Coordinator and approved after discussions.

The following items were discussed and suggested for action in due course of time:

#	Decisions	Persons identified
1.	Hatchery and poultry units should manage in such a way to run them to its full capacity. Revenue by these units should be targeted to get Rs 20,00,000 profits by the end of March, 2017.	SMS (Animal Science)
2.	Apiculture unit at KVK should be upgraded with minimum of three bee colony boxes before end of this month and their proper maintenance towards profitable honey collection.	SMS (Plant Protection)
3.	Development and sale of spices based value added products like juice, jam, pickles, soap, etc should be initiated at the earliest. Visit to Central Horticultural Experiment Station (CHES), Chettalli, IIHR may be carried for exposure and following the low cost food processing principles.	SMS (Home Science)
4	Production of bush pepper in polybags and pots should be @ 200 and 20 numbers respectively per month.	SMS (Horticulture)
5	Unit wise income generation activity should be accelerated and a consolidated report on income and expenditure should be presented during monthly review.	PC and All SMS
6	Activities of soil health card @ 50 numbers and banana micronutrient mixture @ 100 Kg should be prepared on monthly basis.	PA (Lab)
7	Various activities may be carried to enhance the profit and service of ornamental fish unit at KVK.	SMS (Fisheries)
