Research update

Germplasm enrichment

One hundred and five accessions of black pepper, including local cultivars of Arakulam munda, Poonjaran munda, Karimunda, Kaniakadan, Thevanmundi, Neelamundi, Perumkodi and Marampadathi were added to the germplasm repository of the Institute. *Garcinia* germplasm was enriched by adding fifty Northeast collections.

Cardamom genotypes with dual disease resistance Six genotypes of cardamom, namely, IC 547222, IC 547223, IC 349645, IC 349649, IC 547158 and IC 349637, with dual resistance against leaf blight and rhizome rot diseases, were identified.

Cardamom mosaic virus detection by RT-PCR

A procedure for total RNA isolation from cardamom and detection of *Cardamom mosaic virus* (CdMV) through reverse transcription—polymerase chain reaction (RT-PCR) using primers designed for the conserved region of coat protein gene was standardized and the method was validated by testing cardamom samples representing different geographical locations of Karnataka, Kerala and Tamil Nadu.

BBrMV infection in cardamom

One *Nilgiri necrosis* isolate and four *Banana bract mosaic virus* (BBrMV) isolates infecting cardamom, were collected and established under insect-proof glass house conditions. BBrMV infection in cardamom was confirmed by RT-PCR and electron microscopy.

Management of shoot borer (Conogethes punctiferalis) infesting turmeric

Evaluation of four insecticides (malathion 0.1%, carbosulfan 0.075%, imidacloprid 0.0125%, lamda-cyhalothrin 0.0125%) in the field at Peruvannamuzhi for their efficacy in the management of the shoot borer on turmeric indicated that lamdacyhalothrin 0.0125% was the most effective followed by malathion 0.1%.

Cassia lines with high yield and quality

Clonal evaluation of cassia elite lines at Peruvannamuzhi,

indicated the superiority of C1 with regard to dry bark yield.

Among the cassia lines tested at CRC Appangala, the highest dry recovery of bark yield (56.25%) was recorded in IC 370401 at first coppicing. IC 370410, IC 370423 and IC 370425 recorded maximum bark oil yield of 4% and IC 370415 recorded 21% oleoresin content.

Rhizobacteria for ginger

Rhizobacteria were evaluated in field for ginger and the rhizobacterial isolate, GRB-68 showed good germination percentage, disease suppression and better yield followed by GRB-35 and GRB-70. The PGPR strains (GRB-36, GRB-38) when applied in combination with

75%N, 100%P and 100%K positively influenced microbial biomass-C, -N, -P, soil respiration and N-mineralization.

PhytoFuRa

PCR detection using species-specific primer pairs was standardized for *Phytophthora nicotianae, P. capsici* and also *Rhadopholus similis*. The PCR-RFLP method was used to detect *Phytophthora* infection in citrus plants. *PhytoWeb*, a comprehensive portal on *Phytophthora* diseases of horticultural crops in India was developed by modifying the existing *PhyDisH*.

Leaf Spot Disease

One hundred *Colletotrichum* spp. were identified and pure cultured from 150 field samples of cardamom, black pepper and other component crops, of which, colony, conidial and appressorial characteristics of 50 isolates have been recorded. Leaf blight incidence was recorded in 30 germplasm accessions of cardamom during August to March and anthracnose incidence was recorded in 10 black pepper vines during October and March.

News from HRD News from Sarani

During January-June 2010 nine students from various universities completed their M.Sc. project work in Biotechnology, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Bioinformatics and Plantation Development and one student has joined for M Phil project work in Biotechnology.

News from Bioinformatics Centre

The Bioinformatics Centre offered special training to two scientists of ICAR, one each from NRC (Citrus) and NRC (Banana) during 27 January–2 February 2010. During the period, studentship was offered to three post graduate students and two post graduates were offered training in Bioinformatics. A new database, GST Lead Base (www.spicebioinfo.res.in/gstleadbase), containing chemical properties of potential nematicidal compounds that inhibit glutathione-S-transferase in nematodes was developed and hosted.

Consultancy Processing Cell

During January-June 2010, the revenue generation through consultancy activities was around Rs. 2.37 lakhs. A share of 44% of the amount was generated by offering summer training to MSc students from different educational institutions and the rest from analysis of soil and manure samples for different nutrients and analysis of biocontrol agents.

News from Library
