**Proceedings of the Farm Advisory Committee meeting held on 03-05-2006**

The farm advisory committee meeting was held in Seminar Hall (Old. Lab. Building) at 1.30 PM on 03-05-06 and it was chaired by the Head of the Station. The following committee members were attended the meeting.

The decisions of the previous meeting were reviewed and the following decisions were taken.

1. Fence trimming work at Appangala has to be carried out with our own supporting staff and for Quarters area at Madikeri it can be given on contract. (Action: SIC (Farm and Tech. Assistants.)
2. Shade regulation work is to be undertaken in a phased manner.
3. All the staff except Supporting Staff have to enter their movement in the movement register which is kept at office and their movements should be known to their immediate controlling Officers.
4. The proposals for petty works to be undertaken in respective Sections during the current financial year should be submitted to the office with in 15 days (Action: SIC (Farm) and Tech. Assistants.
5. The retail sale price of the following farm produce has to be revised in order to equate with the prevailing market price. But for sale of graded cardamom the expenditure involved for grading should be realized since the produce available in the market cannot be equated with graded cardamom available at this Centre. The revision of prices is as follows.

6. Proposals for insecticides are to be consolidated in consultation with the Scientists as per the requirement. (Action: Technical Assistants)
7. Periodical spraying is to be carried out as per schedule without any break. (Action: Technical Assistants)
8. During the leave period of Shri L. Balakrishna, the meteorological data has to be recorded invariably by Shri K.A. Somanna/K. Ananda T-4. The necessary orders to this effect is to be issued (Action: AAO)

The decisions of the previous meeting were reviewed and the following decisions were taken.

1. Planting at block No.9, 0.4 ha of Multi location trial block and 0.8 ha at Appangala block is to be carried out in a phased manner. (Action: Dr. SJA/Dr. DP/Mr. L. Balakrishna)
2. The following Insecticides/Fungicides/fertilizers are to be procured for need based spraying in experimental and bulk blocks. (Action: SIC (Farm/KB Prasanna Kumar/AAO).  
Chlorophyriphos –10 lits; Quinolphos-20 lits; Thimet-50 kgs; Furodon-100 kgs;COC-50 kgs; Sandowit-5 lits; Complex 400 kgs; Urea 1000 kgs; Muriate of potash-1500 kgs; SSP-2000 kgs; DAP-200 kgs; and Faram yard Manure-800 cft (4 loads).
3. In view change of residence by Shri Balakrishna, hereafter the maintenance of Residential buildings at KHB colony Madikeri will be looked after by him and and Shri K.A. Somanna, will look after at Appangala under the supervision/guidance of the OIC (Bldgs). (Action: AAO).
4. All the Technical Assistants are required to maintain dairy invariably and the works attended by them are to be entered in their dairy, which will be checked by the immediate controlling officer concerned periodically. Similarly all the Technical staff are hereby instructed to submit the dairy at least once in every fortnight to the Head for verification.(Action: Dr. SJA/Dr.D.P and All Tech.Assistants).
5. The vacant site at KHB colony, Madikeri are in the name of Housing Board. The necessary action is to be initiated to set right the records at an early date. (Action: AAO).

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
